

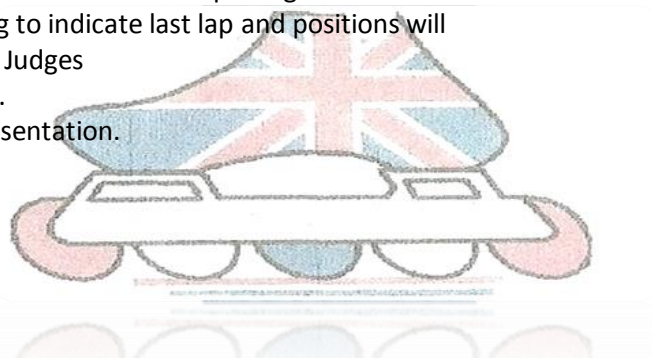

Conditions of Contest

- 1) A bell will be rung to denote the last lap.
- 2) Skaters must follow instructions from race officials. This will be carried out with the Use of a Whistle followed by instruction.
- 3) Skaters may be asked to move over to be lapped.
- 4) Skaters may be asked to leave the track via disqualification or other infringement
- 5) Under the referees request the lap board may be frozen and skaters asked to reduce speed until it is safe for the race to continue.
- 6) Two Judges slips will be taken for an infringement or one judge's slip & the referee.
- 7) The program may be altered on the day at the discretion of the officials.
- 8) Crash Hats must be worn at all times on the track.
- 9) If a skater starts the time in error on 300m TT this will be the recorded time
- 10) 500m Heats determined by TT results in serpentine method.
- 11) The winner and runner up of each heat for the 500m final.
- 12) The winner of each heat and the 5 fastest times for the 1000m final.
- 13) **Points** – 2 & 1 for the first two skaters on points lap except final lap where, 3,2,1 will be given in the according finishing order across the line.
- 14) **Points** – Failure to complete will lose points and awarded position in **order of retirement**.
- 15) **Devil** – Eliminations continue **until there are 4 skaters** left on the final lap.
- 16) **Devil** - Athlete with the last part of the skate across the line is eliminated.
- 17) **Sole Skaters** will have the time set by the referee to achieve for a placing to be met.
- 18) When Skaters are “not racing” a Bell can be rung to indicate last lap and positions will stand, this is at the discretion of the Referee & two Judges
- 19) Medals will be awarded for 1st , 2nd ,& 3rd places.
- 20) Skates and Team Skinsuits are to be worn at presentation.
